Students will be placed in one of the following positions upon arrival. All participants need to be flexible to the position assigned upon arrival. Position can vary including Housekeeping, kitchen utility, busser, host, cafeteria worker, and retail:

Housekeeping

Responsible for daily cleaning of assigned section of guest, include making beds, cleaning bathrooms, dusting, amenities, recycling/composting, removing dirty linens and completing closing duties.



Kitchen Utility

Responsible for cleaning and sanitizing all cooking utensils, dishware, pots/pans, and work areas. Duties include clean and organize back dock including surrounding areas, sweep and mop kitchen floors, break room areas, floors, employee restrooms, walls and shelves including walk-ins. Take out trash and clean trash receptacles. Restock dishes, paper towels, and trash liners.

Busser

Responsible for greeting guests and make them feel welcome throughout their dining experience, setting tables according to house standards and meal period placements. Assist in keeping dining room clean and orderly throughout shift. Take dirty dishes to dish area in kitchen.

Host

Responsible for greeting guests as they approach and make them feel welcome. Field phone calls as necessary and seat the guest(s) as quickly as possible or if table is not immediately available, accurately informing the guest(s) of how long the wait period will be.

Cafeteria Worker / Food outlet adttendant

Responsible in serving line, ensuring that all items are fully stocked at all times while maintaining portion control and proper presentation of the item(s) served. Keep serving line clean and sanitary at all times, maintaining temperature logs and sanitation logs. Use proper rotation of product on perishable items at all times considering the First in First out method. Clear and sanitize tables in dining area. Take dirty dishes to dish area in kitchen. Ensure that side stands are fully stocked with condiments, eating utensils and napkins.

Retail

Responsible for assisting customers with politeness and knowledgeable manner, handling store security issues as directed by store management, completing assigned job board on daily basis, and responsible for issue bank including change orders and security of the bank.





*You must be available to work nights, weekends and holidays. You may work as few as 4 days/week and up to 6 days/week. The schedule might change weekly and you must be prepared to work accordingly.


• Require participants to apply for SSN before arrival at worksite

- Perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending at the knee to clean for up to 8 hours per day.
- No visible tattoos and no facial piercing. Must have normal colored hair, and no facial tattoos.
- Students need to be prepared for long periods of standing and walking as well as carrying heavy objects. Housekeepers will be required to work in small spaces such as shower and toilet areas.
- Required to walk or stand for entire shift, push/pull up to 40 lbs frequently (up to 100 lbs occasionally) and lift to 50 lbs frequently (up to 100 lbs occasionally).
 Lifting requirement: 75 lbs / 34 kgs.
- Handling cleaning chemicals, working outdoor under direct sunlight, and standing for entire shift.

• **Overtime** is paid after 40 hours.
