**Position:** **Resort Workers**

Students will be placed in one of the following positions upon arrival. All participants need to be flexible to the position assigned upon arrival. Position can vary including Housekeeping, kitchen utility, Server Assistant/busser, host, Food Outlet Attendant/cafe/teria worker, Pizza Pub Attendant, retail, and Guest Service Agent:

- **Housekeeping**

Responsible for daily cleaning of assigned section of guest, include making beds, cleaning bathrooms, dusting, amenities, recycling/composting, removing dirty linens and completing closing duties.

- **Kitchen Utility**

Responsible for cleaning and sanitizing all cooking utensils, dishware, pots/pans, and work areas. Duties include clean and organize back dock including surrounding areas, sweep and mop kitchen floors, break room areas, floors, employee restrooms, walls and shelves including walk-ins. Take out trash and clean trash receptacles. Restock dishes, paper towels, trash liners, and miscellaneous stock items.

- **Server Assistant/Busser**

Responsible for greeting guests and make them feel welcome throughout their dining experience, setting tables according to house standards and meal period placements, clearing finished tables in an expedient manner, and clearing excess settings after guests have been seated. Assist in keeping dining room clean and orderly throughout shift. Take dirty dishes to dish area in kitchen.

- **Host**

Responsible for greeting guests as they approach and make them feel welcome. Field phone calls as necessary and seat the guest(s) as quickly as possible or if table is not immediately available, accurately informing the guest(s) of how long the wait period will be.

- **Food Outlet Attendant/Cafeteria Worker**

Responsible for keeping the serving line fully stocked, clean, and properly presented, while following portion control and FIFO rotation. Notify when items are running low/replacement items needed. Maintain temperature and sanitation logs, clear and sanitize tables, restock condiments and utensils, and take dirty dishes to the kitchen. Take dirty dishes to dish area

- **Pizza Pub Attendant**

Greet and seat guests using a computerized system, assist with to-go orders, clear and reset tables, and help maintain a clean and welcoming dining room while staying informed about restaurant hours and current menu items.

- **Guest Service Agent**

Greet all guests and assist with any questions. Check guests in/out of rooms. Operate POS system, manage payments and posting charges to rooms. Maintain guest security, manage assigning guests, manage cash bank

- **Retail**

Responsible for assisting customers with politeness and knowledgeable manner, handling store security issues as directed by store management, completing assigned job board on daily basis, and responsible for issue bank including change orders and security of the bank. Be aware of product locations, sizes, prices, ect, operate POS system maintaining accurate entries, charges, change, and deposits, cashiering, customer service, stocking, cleaning, and sales floor, and be able to lift and carry up to 20 lbs.

**Requirement**

- Require participants to apply for SSN before arrival at worksite
- Perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending at the knee to clean for up to 8 hours per day.
- No visible tattoos and no facial piercing. Must have normal colored hair, and no facial tattoos.
- Students need to be prepared for long periods of standing and walking as well as carrying heavy objects. Housekeepers will be required to work in small spaces such as shower and toilet areas.
- Required to walk or stand for entire shift, push/pull up to 40 lbs frequently (up to 100 lbs occasionally) and lift to 50 lbs frequently (up to 100 lbs occasionally). Lifting requirement: 50 lbs / 22 kgs.
- Handling cleaning chemicals, working outdoor under direct sunlight, and standing for entire shift.

**Other**

- **Overtime** is paid after 40 hours.
