#### **How to Get There**

We recommend flying into the <u>Cleveland Hopkins International Airport</u> (airport code CLE).

Travel from the airport to the Greyhound Station by taking the RTA (Rapid Transit Authority) RED LINE train to the Tower City-Public Square stop. Then take an RTA bus to 15th Street and Chester Ave. From the Greyhound bus station (1465 Chester Ave) take a bus to Sandusky, OH. Visit Greyhound to confirm schedules and fares at <a href="https://www.greyhound.com">www.greyhound.com</a>.

Please note: Students should arrive at the Human Resources office between the hours of **8am** and **4pm**, no earlier than **24** hours before you are scheduled to start work. \*Cedar Point housing is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If you arrive after 4pm, you can "check-in" to housing at the Commons Store. Students arriving after 4pm should report to Human Resources between 8:30am-9:30am the following morning.
