Student will be responsible for keeping guest rooms clean to our and Comfort Inn's high standards. They will collect dirty linens, make beds, clean bathrooms- including toilets, tubs, sinks, and floors. They will also dust, and vacuum. Students will also clean the common areas of the hotel. They must be able to lift 20lbs. and work on their feet for up to 8 hours.

Job duties may include:

- Removing and collecting linens for laundering and transporting them to designated areas.
- Cleaning rugs, carpets, and upholstered furniture using vacuum cleaner.
- Dusting furniture and equipment.
- Emptying wastebaskets and cleaning them inside and out.
- Cleaning tiled floors with the use of brooms and mops.
- Using chemical-based products to clean tubs, sinks, countertops, mirrors, toilets, door panels and shower curtains.
- Replenishing trash bags, soaps, bathroom items, and other supplies.
- Transporting all trash and waste to disposal areas, as instructed.
- Removing items from refrigerator, stove, and microwave.
- Cleaning refrigerator, stove, microwave, and any additional appliances inside and out.
- Demonstrate a high level of customer service. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests.
- Keep supervisor/manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency situations, damages, and potential safety hazards.
- Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all additional training courses.
- Perform all duties in a safe manner.
- Employees may be asked to move to different locations or job assignments within the property, as needed. Other duties may be assigned.

Room Attendants are paid at \$5.00 per room cleaned. Room Attendants are expected to clean 2 rooms per hour, which results in \$10.00 per hour. Typically Room Attendants will work 6-8 hours per day 5-6 days per week making a minimum of \$9.00 per hour for all time worked. Please keep in mind we can be busier with longer days during peak periods or slower during lulls. Our work depends solely on business levels.

Specific qualifications required:

Able to bend and lift up to 20lb. objects. Be able to pay attention to detail. Rooms are checked daily. It is the responsibility of the student to do the room correctly and up to our high standards.

- Due to the duties of this job, employees can't have allergies to cleaning chemicals or dirt/dust. Face masks may be provided, if needed.
- Must have the ability to read, write, and understand instructions given in the English language.
