## How to Get There

**Students MUST communicate their travel plans with their Employer at least 2 weeks prior to arrival.**

It is recommended that students fly into the **Chicago O'Hare Airport (ORD)** in Chicago, IL and then take a Greyhound Bus to Wisconsin Dells.

Ways to get from Chicago to the Wisconsin Dells:

1. From Chicago, students can also contact [US Work and Travel Shuttles](#). Students should email for rates and pick up times.
2. Greyhound bus to the Wisconsin Dells. Take a bus (a few dollars), Taxi (\$55), or Airport Shuttle (\$35) to the Downtown Chicago Greyhound Bus Station located at 630 West Harrison Street, Chicago, IL 60607. Book a trip from Chicago to Wisconsin Dells. **\*\*Please Note that the bus from Chicago to Wisconsin Dells departs ONLY two times per day and the trip is about 5 hours long. Check the schedule [here](#) to make sure that you will be able to make the connection. If you are arriving in Chicago late at night, we recommend going to HIY Hostel in downtown Chicago (\$45 per person per night). We do not recommend that students spend the night in the bus station for safety reasons.**

3. If students arrive early enough you can also catch the Amtrak train from Chicago to the Wisconsin Dells. Please check the [Amtrak](#) schedule to see what will work best for you.

Students who fly into the General Mitchell International Airport (MKE) in Milwaukee, WI or the Dane County Regional Airport (MSN) in Madison, WI can contact [Wisconsin Dells Kangaroo Taxi and Shuttle](#) for more information about shuttle times and prices.

Next you will choose to either ride the Greyhound Bus or the Amtrak train to Wisconsin Dells:

To the Greyhound Station: Get off the train and exit the station. Walk one block South on Clinton Street to Harrison Street. Go right on Harrison Street. The Downtown Chicago Greyhound Bus Station will be one block ahead at 630 West Harrison. Be sure to look for scheduled times at [www.greyhound.com](http://www.greyhound.com). The Greyhound Bus will drop you off in Wisconsin Dells at the Citgo Gas Station at 611 Frontage Road at the crossroads of Highway 13 and County Road H, Wisconsin Dells, WI.

To the Amtrak Station: Get off the train and exit the station. Walk a short distance east on the ramp. Turn left on S. Clinton Street. Walk 0.16 mile North on S. Clinton Street. Walk straight on Union Station walkway. Turn right on Union Station Clinton/Jackson. Walk a short distance North on Union Station Clinton/Jackson. Turn right on Union Station Walkway. Walk a short distance east on Union Station Walkway. Arrive at the Amtrak Station. Total Walking in 0.32 miles. Be sure to look for scheduled times at [www.amtrak.com](http://www.amtrak.com). The train will arrive in Downtown Wisconsin Dells.

Option 2: Midway International Airport (Chicago) to Wisconsin Dells via Greyhound Bus

Midway Airport is connected to downtown Chicago by the CTA Orange Line. Tickets can be purchased at the Midway Orange Line station, which is conveniently located near the airport right across Cicero Avenue. From Midway Airport take the Orange Line to Quincy/Wells Street, exit train. Take the #7 bus to Harrison/Jefferson Street and then exit the bus. Greyhound Bus Station is located at 630 West Harrison. Be sure to look for scheduled times at [www.greyhound.com](http://www.greyhound.com). The Greyhound Bus will drop you off in Wisconsin Dells at the Citgo Gas Station at 611 Frontage Road at the crossroads of Highway 13 and County Road H, Wisconsin Dells, WI.

Option 3: Milwaukee Mitchell International Airport to Wisconsin Dells via Greyhound Bus:

Position title: Lifeguard

Description of position:

Lifeguards are responsible for providing friendly customer service to waterpark guests while ensuring their safety. The job will include maintaining the established standards of performance, service, hospitality, cleanliness and safety in the pool/waterpark area at all times to maximize guest satisfaction. Wilderness lifeguards are responsible for communicating with guests on resort amenities and procedural standards. Lifeguards represent the face of the resort and should always be confident in guest interaction. Ensure guest safety in indoor pools and amusements.

Students not passing the certification for lifeguard will be placed as a slide attendant.

Specific qualifications required:

The Red Cross Certification Course lasts for 28 hours and is required. In order to be a Lifeguard certified by the American Red Cross, students must be able to swim 300 continuous yards (275 meters) - including 100 yards of Freestyle (front crawl), 100 yards of Breaststroke, 100 yards of any combination of those two strokes. They must also swim 20 yards (either Freestyle or Breaststroke), retrieve a 10-pound (4.5 kilos) object from 7(2.2 meters) feet of water, and return 20 yards while holding it above the water with both hands and keeping their head above water. Students will also need to be able to tread water for 2 minutes using just their legs. In addition, the participants must possess an above-average English level due to the fact that the course, study materials and exams are all given in English. We do not provide a translator during the entire course, including exams.

Any students that do not pass the Lifeguard Certification Course may be transferred to another department depending upon staffing needs. However, if the number of failed participants is excessive they may be released from their agreement.
