What is the weather like at the Grand Canyon North Rim?

The Grand Canyon is a steep-sided canyon carved by the Colorado River in the state of Arizona. Weather in the Grand Canyon varies according to elevation. Conditions in the Grand Canyon region are generally dry, but substantial precipitation occurs twice annually, during winter and late summer. Temperatures vary wildly throughout the year, with summer highs within the Inner Gorge commonly exceeding 100°F (37.8°C) and winter minimum temperatures sometimes falling below 0°F (-17.8° C) along the canyon's rims.
