- The Grand Canyon is a chasm 277 miles long and up to 18 miles wide
- Was made a national monument in 1908 and became a national park in 1919
- Includes approximately 70 species of mammals, 250 species of birds, 25 types of reptiles and five species of amphibians
- Mules are chosen from Tennessee and Missouri. They are used for pack supplies to Phantom Ranch and pack mail out of the canyon and later promoted to trail mules
- The first Europeans to visit the Grand Canyon were Spanish and they arrived 473 years ago

What is the weather like at the Grand Canyon North Rim?

The Grand Canyon is a steep-sided canyon carved by the Colorado River in the state of Arizona. Weather in the Grand Canyon varies according to elevation. Conditions in the Grand Canyon region are generally dry, but substantial precipitation occurs twice annually, during winter and late summer. Temperatures vary wildly throughout the year, with summer highs within the Inner Gorge commonly exceeding 100°F (37.8°C) and winter minimum temperatures sometimes falling below 0°F (-17.8°C) along the canyon's rims.
