Position:

- **Lifeguard/ Slide Attendant**

Responsible for ensuring guest safety at all times in the waterpark. Lifeguards and Slide attendants will receive red-cross certification training after arrival.

Pay rate: \$14.00 per hour for Slide Attendants; \$15.00 per hour for Shallow Water Lifeguard; \$15.25 per hour for Deep Water Lifeguard; and \$15.50 for Wave Pool lifeguard; Extra \$1 an hour for Lifeguards w/ open availability. Pay rate \$7.25 during training.

- **Attraction Attendant**

Duties in this position include but are not limited to: attending monthly in-service dates, inspecting the courses that are being worked that day, overseeing a three-story dry play structure. Zip Line and Ropes Course attendants must fill out appropriate checklists for each attraction. Take

Flight attendants must ensure that guests are properly strapped into the Ride Bay and hit the appropriate safety button informing the Controller that their floor is safe to start the ride. Go Kart attendants must check the tracks and report any damage to supervisor. Duties also include ensuring that guests are properly fitted with correct harnesses and gear of each attraction, ensuring guests watch appropriate safety videos, and ensuring that guests meet height and weight requirements. Must also keep ride/attraction areas clean and interact with guests to direct them to the location. General cleaning is required and additional tasks will be assigned as necessary, possibly in other departments.

- **Outlet Cook/Kitchen Assistant**

Duties in this position include but are not limited to: cooking food for guests in the Quick Service Dining outlets, preparing deli to go items as needed, putting orders away on delivery days in their designated location, assisting guests, maintaining the cleanliness of all areas and equipment, and maintaining all state regulatory health codes. General cleaning is required and additional duties may be assigned by supervisor.

- **Retail/Gift Shop Cashier**

Duties include but are not limited to: Stock shelves, counters, or tables with merchandise, set up advertising displays or arrange merchandise on counters or tables to promote sales, stamp, mark, or tag price on merchandise, answer customer's questions concerning location, price, and use of merchandise, total price and tax on merchandise purchased by customer to determine bill, wrap or bag merchandise for customers, clean shelves, counters, or tables., remove and record amount of cash in register at end of shift, ensure resort guests are receiving the highest quality service levels as possible. General cleaning is required and additional duties will be assigned by supervisor as necessary.

- **Special Events**

Duties in this position include, but are not limited to: Acknowledging guests with appropriate greeting and inquiring whether there is anything that you can do for them, engaging in lighthearted and professional

conversation is encouraged, decorating for all resort parties. General cleaning is required and additional hours may be assigned by supervisor as necessary.

- **Busser**

Participants hired in this position will be in charge of maintaining the quality and ambiance of the restaurant. Duties in lightening the load of all wait staff when there is an influx of service requests by processing payment, maintaining the quality of food service, order taking and plating for each table, wearing proper uniform/nametag at all times, organizing tables efficiently without making noise, serving water and refilling glasses as and when needed, cleaning the dining area and serving stations, assisting janitorial staff with trash removal, assisting in cleaning up spills, greeting guests with/in the absence of the hostess, making suggestions about menu selections when asked, maintaining a clean, well-stocked and presentable work environment, handling customers' queries and concerns efficiently.

- **Waterpark Attendant**

Waterpark Attendants are responsible for ensuring guest safety at all times and maintaining order in the waterpark. The pay rate is \$7.25 during training and \$13.00 per hour after training. Participants will ensure that each guest receives outstanding guest service by providing a friendly environment, as well as inspecting facilities for cleanliness. Participants will develop a high level of resort knowledge to serve as a contact point for guests in need of assistance. Other job duties are assigned by manager(s) as necessary. General cleaning is required.

- Employer provides shared dormitory-style housing with shared bathrooms. Housing is located within walking distance of work site and each room will have a microwave and small refrigerator. A full shared kitchen is available, but it must be kept clean. Failure to keep kitchen clean may result in kitchen closing for 2-3 days. Coin-operated laundry is available on-site. Bed linens will not be provided by employer, but participants can purchase extra-long twin sheets, pillow case, pillow, bath towel, washcloth and laundry bag from employer for \$35 (will be payroll deducted).
- **Housing deposit:** \$300

Transportation to Worksite: Walking distance / Bicycle

Public Transportation: Taxi / Bicycle

Requirement **All positions require:**
To have good work ethic, attendance, and be able to clean using common cleaning products.

Attractions Attendant

- Must be able to work a physical job, including heavy lifting, bending, and walking up and down stairs. Must be able to lift and/or move up to 25 lbs/11.3 kgs and occasionally 50 lbs/23 kgs.

Lifeguard

- Must be able to swim at least 50 meters (strong swimmer)
- Students must pass lifeguard certification. All Lifeguards MUST pay \$80 for the Red-Cross Certification textbook and certificate. The Red Cross Certification is free (except the cost of textbook and certificate) but any lifeguard/slide attendant staff that does not complete their Job Offer Agreement dates will have to be charged approximately \$200 for the cost of the Lifeguard Certification course.

Outlet Cook/Kitchen Assistant

- Must be able to work a physical job, including heavy lifting, bending, and walking up and down stairs. Must be able to lift and/or move up to 25 lbs/11.3 kgs and occasionally 50 lbs/23 kgs.
- Should be comfortable handling pork.

Retail / Gift Shop Cashier

- Must be able to work a physical job, including walking, standing, lifting, bending, and walking up and down stairs. Must be able to

lift and/or move up to 10 lbs/4.5 kgs and occasionally 25 lbs/11.3 kgs.

- May occasionally work in wet or humid conditions (non-weather), in addition to various outdoor weather conditions.

Special Events

- Must be able to work a physical job, including lifting, bending, and walking up and down stairs. Must be able to lift and/or move up to 25 lbs/11.3 kgs.

Busser

- Must be able to work a physical job, including heavy lifting, bending, and walking up and down stairs.
- Must be able to lift and/or move up to 25 pounds (11.3 kgs) and occasionally 50 pounds (23 kgs).

Waterpark Attendant

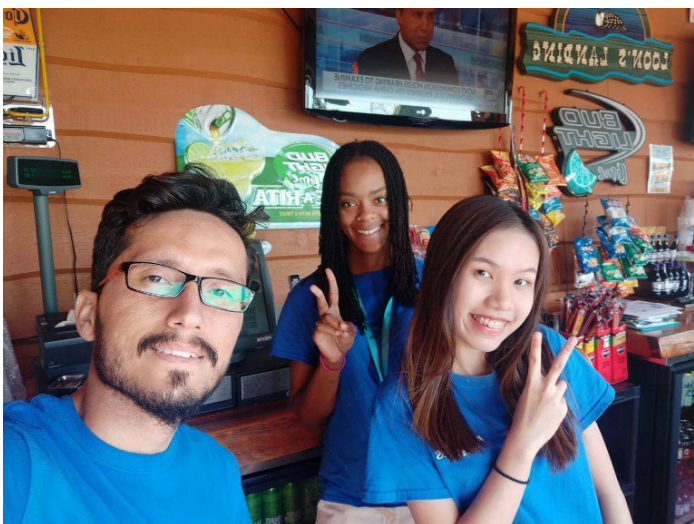
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time and be able to lift up to 50 pounds (23 kilograms).
- Must be comfortable working in wet conditions and outdoors.
- Participant should be comfortable handling cleaning chemicals.

Other

- **Overtime** is paid after 40 hours.
