Did you know...?

- Cars and other motor vehicles are not allowed on Mackinac Island and have been banned since 1898
- Mackinac Island is separated from the mainland of Michigan by 3 miles (4.8 km) of water.
- The island has a year-round population of just 492 people but in the summer have as many as 15,000 visitors per day.

- At 5 miles long, the Mackinac Bridge is one of the longest suspension bridges in the world. It took 3 years to complete and was opened in 1957.
- Bordering 4 of the 5 [Great Lakes](#), Michigan has the longest freshwater shoreline of any state.

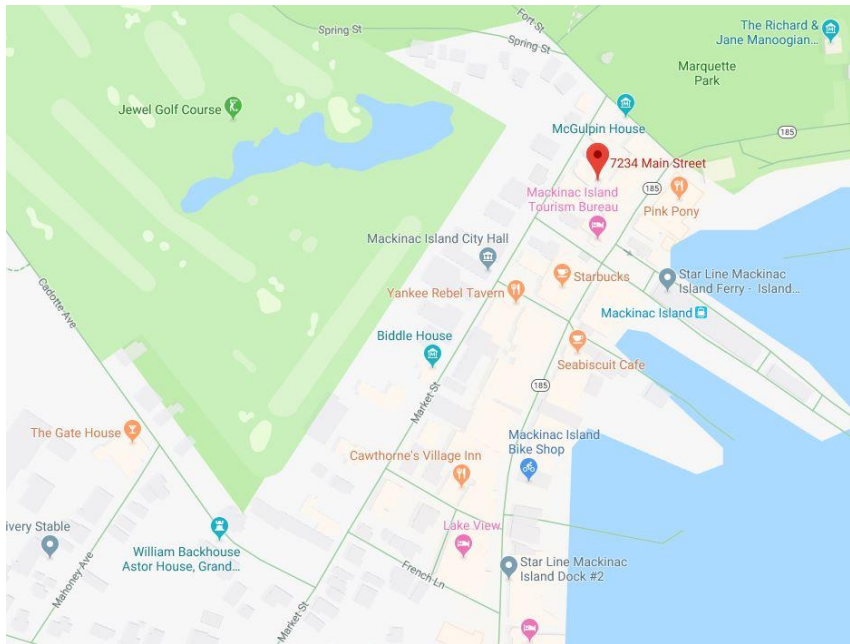
What is the weather like on Mackinac Island, Michigan?

Mackinac Island's climate is mild during summer when temperatures tend to be around 60°F (15°C). The warmest month of the year is July with an average maximum temperature of 75°F (24°C). Temperature variations between night and day tend to be fairly limited during summer with a difference that can reach 15°F.
