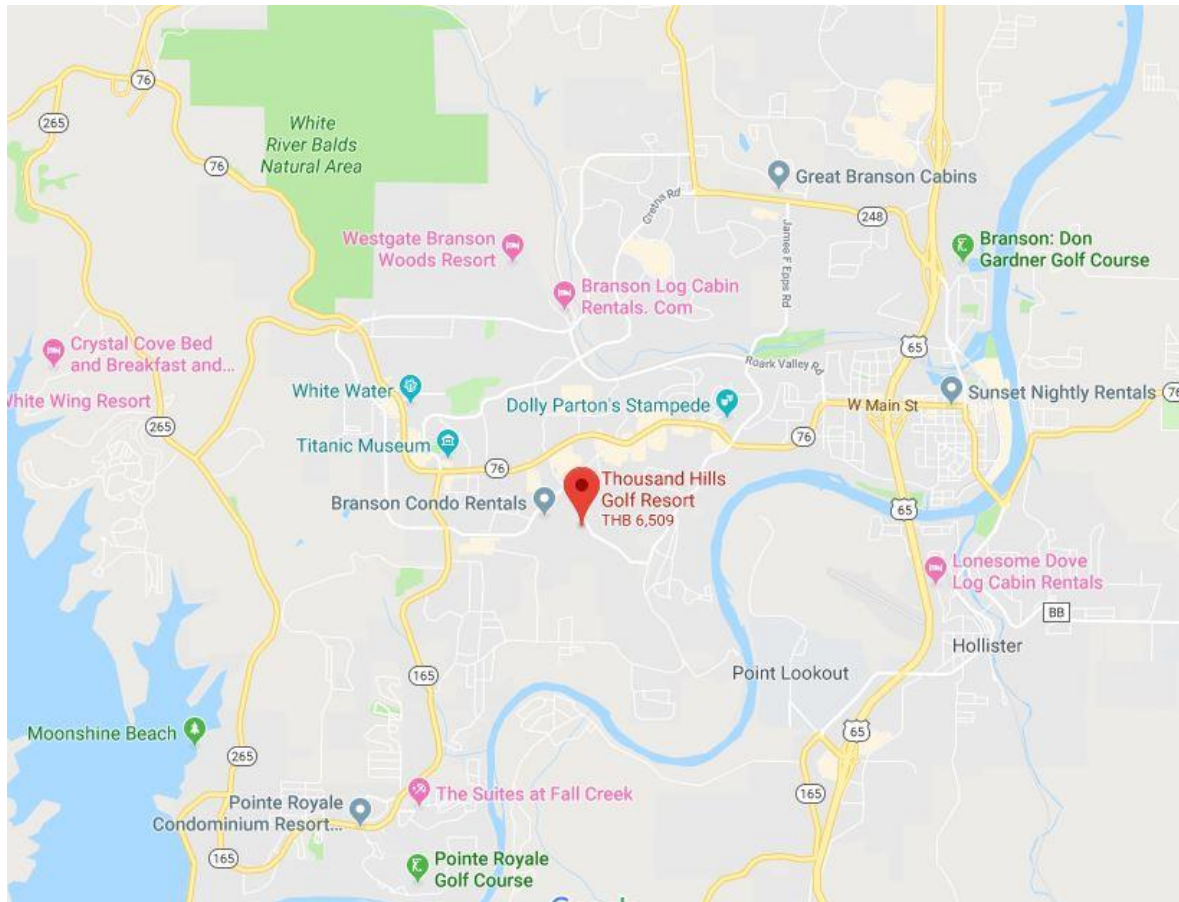

Weather in Branson:

Branson, Missouri experiences all four seasons. During the fall, Branson's hills transform into fabulous autumn colors with radiant shades of red and gold throughout the months of September and October. The daily highs average 75° F (24° C) and there is low humidity. Branson has a fairly mild winter with January and February rarely bringing snowfall and average temperatures around 45° F (7° C). During the spring season of March, April and May, the days start to warm up. Daily high temperatures average 66° F (19° C). In the summer months of June, July and August days are warm with average temperatures of 87° F (30° C) which make it a perfect place to go swimming in one of the three lake areas.
