Weather in Altoona, IA



How to Get There

Students should plan to fly into <u>Des Moines International Airport (DSM)</u>. From the airport, students can take a taxi, Lyft, or Uber to Adventureland Inn, where we will meet students and take them to their arranged housing. Students should plan to arrive between the hours of 6am-5pm (06h-17h) and must let us know their arrival information at least 2 weeks before arriving in the US.

If arriving after hours, students can book a hotel in Des Moines for the night and travel to Adventureland Inn the following day. We recommend the Ramada at Des Moines Airport, which has an airport shuttle. Please check with the hotel for current room rates.
