Details of purchasing required clothing or footwear: A LandShark T-shirt is provided but students must bring or buy closed-toe non-slip footwear. Server and host positions must bring or buy khaki shorts (no shorter than 5" above knee) or khaki pants. Kitchen help positions must bring or buy either black or khaki pants. For all positions, no "cargo-style" shorts or pants allowed. If pants or shorts have belt loops, then a belt must be worn.

CLOTHING & UNIFORM - must wear clean and wrinkle-free clothing while on duty.

JEWELRY - worn in good taste and must not interfere with service. Except for earrings, no visible piercing permitted. Women permitted to wear one small plain ring and two matched sets of earrings, no larger than a quarter. Men permitted to wear one small plain ring per hand. Plain post earrings no larger than 1/4" or hoop earrings no larger than a dime may be worn at the bottom of the earlobe. One watch & one bracelet per arm permitted for FOH and Retail Staff. No sweatbands.

HAIR - hair must be clean and neatly styled. Unacceptable hair styles include but are not limited to: extreme styling, shaving part of the head or eyebrows, or cutting or dying designs into the hair; dying the full head of hair more than one color or colors unnatural to human hair; multiple-colored highlights, lowlights, or streaks in large sections of the hair, covering over 25% of the total head; hair that covers one or both eyes; or hair extensions that are not consistent with the overall hair color. Beards, goatees, and mustaches are permitted. Facial hair must be fully developed and well-groomed. The length should not exceed 1/2 ".

NAILS - all be one length, clean, and trimmed no longer than 1/4" beyond the fingertip. Nail polish one color only and may be clear, natural, or subtle color. No decals, jewelry, sparkles, or patterns and chipped nail polish is not acceptable. Back-of-house must wear gloves in all food preparation areas when nail polish or acrylic nails are applied.

TATTOOS - minimal visible tattoos and should be tasteful and appropriate.

GOOD PHYSICAL AND ORAL HYGIENE - must practice good physical and oral hygiene. Be neat & clean at all times. Use natural-looking cosmetics; use fragrance sparingly; shower daily, use deodorant; must take all measures to prevent unpleasant odors after smoking.
