Guest Services Workers also provide a concierge service to the guests. Check in and check out guests renting boats. Communicate basic boat usage and safety information to all guests renting boats ensuring all required paperwork is completed. Be highly knowledgeable about the marina and the surrounding areas; acting as a concierge resource for all guests. Assist customers in docking and piloting boats in and out of the marina. Go the extra mile and follow through to ensure guest satisfaction.

- **Marina Services Worker / Dockhand - Boat Rentals**

The Dockhand is responsible for ensuring guest satisfaction at the marina location by assisting boat crew with vehicle navigation, assisting guests with boat operations, properly maintaining the dock area(s), and providing general customer service. Cleans and maintains docks, restrooms, and public areas. Ensure customers understand boating safety and assist customers with docking of boats. - **Marina Services Worker- Fuel Dock**

Fuel Dock /Marina Service Workers primarily work as Fuel Attendants – assisting guests with the purchase of gas, oil and accessories. Service Workers are flexible, willing to help out wherever needed, comfortable working outside in extreme heat conditions and committed to delivering the highest levels of customer service. Service Workers also provide a concierge service to guests - always highly knowledgeable on Lake Powell Resorts and Marinas and the surrounding area. Essential functions include but are not limited to: performing daily safety tasks;

fueling boats; checking engine oil; cleaning the fuel dock, barges and other relevant areas (including restrooms); rolling fuel hoses; changing filters; washing decks; and emptying trash. Will handle cash, credit cards and traveler's checks. Must be proficient in counting money, providing change and make accurate deposits at the end of shift.

- **Food Prep Worker**

Stocks and maintains appropriate levels of product. Prepare a variety of food according to production guidelines and standardized recipes. Cleans and sanitizes work areas, equipment, and utensils. 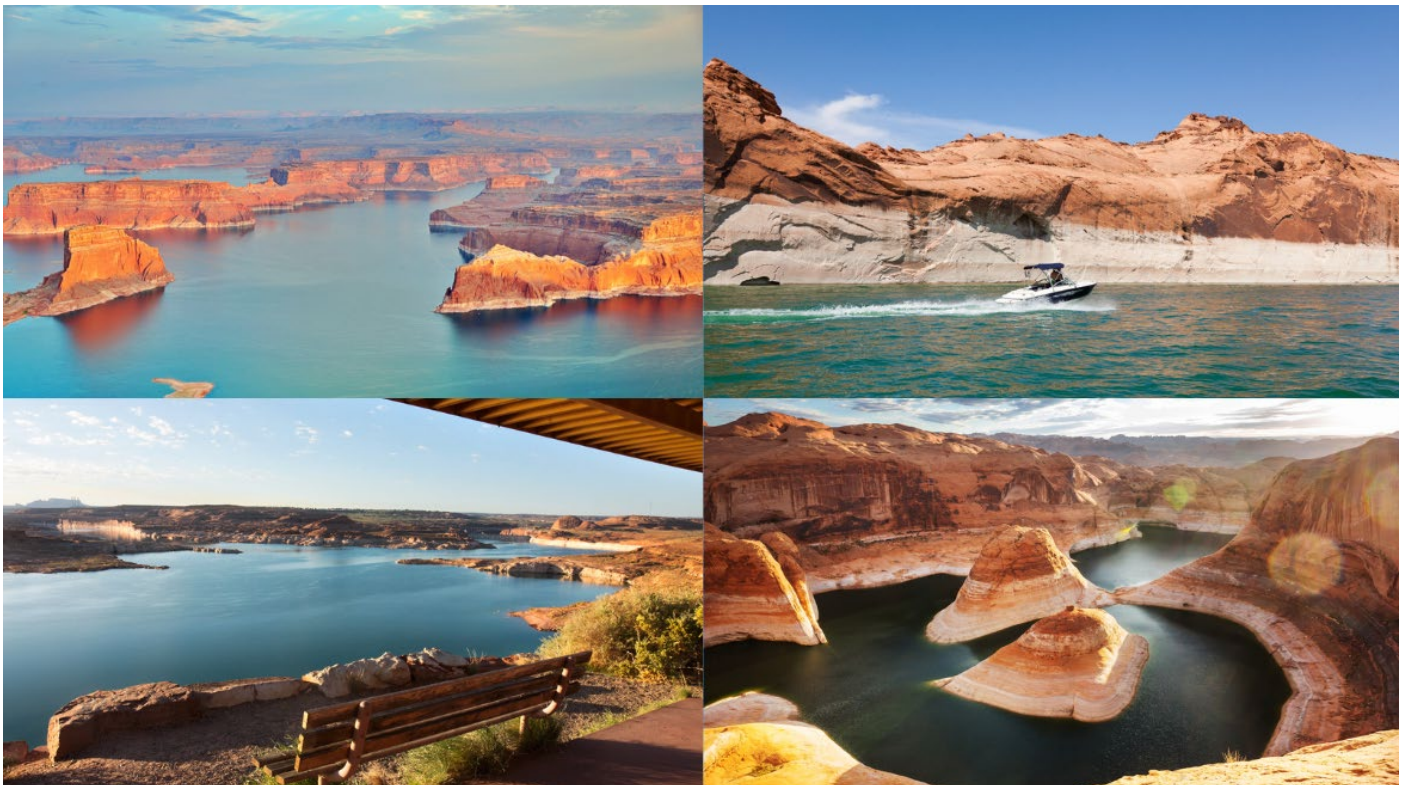
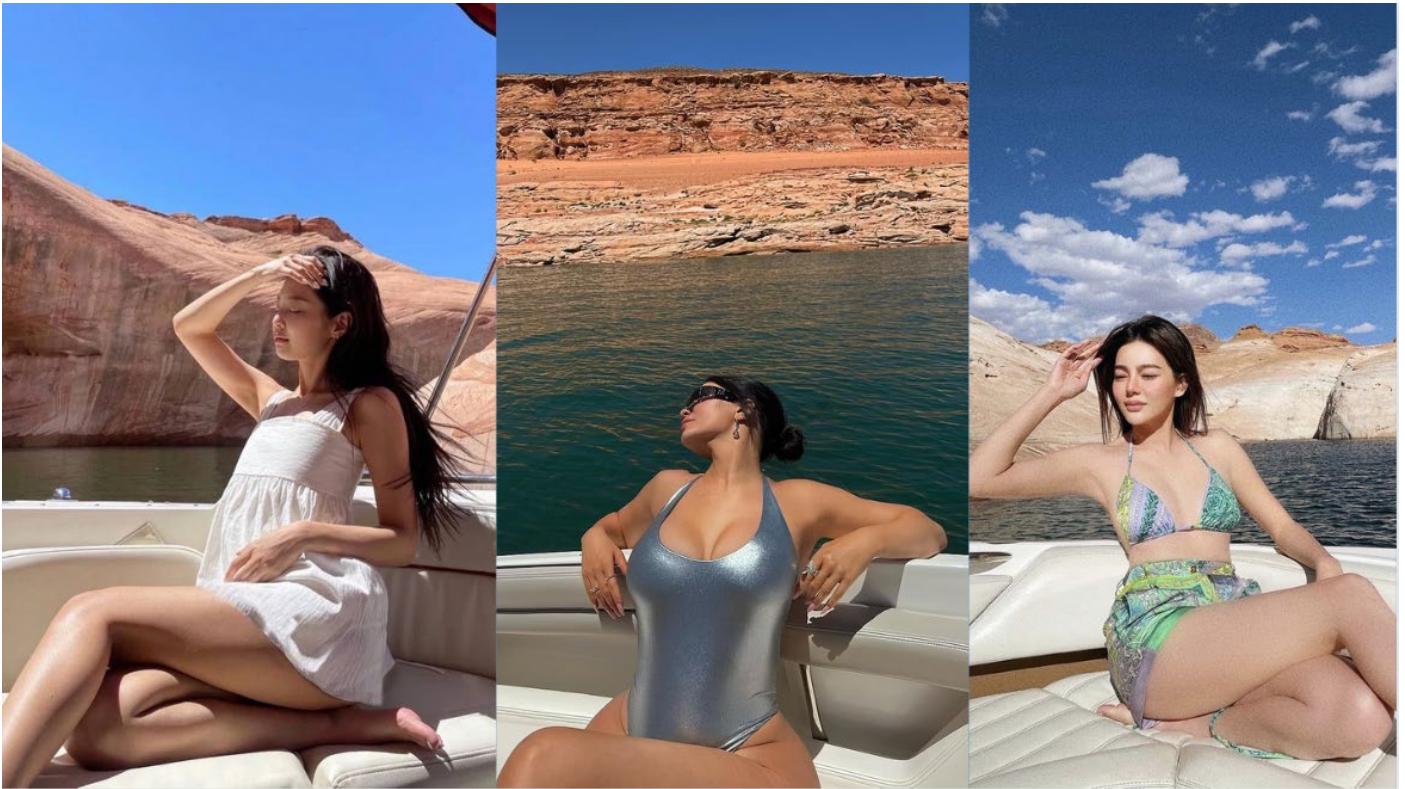

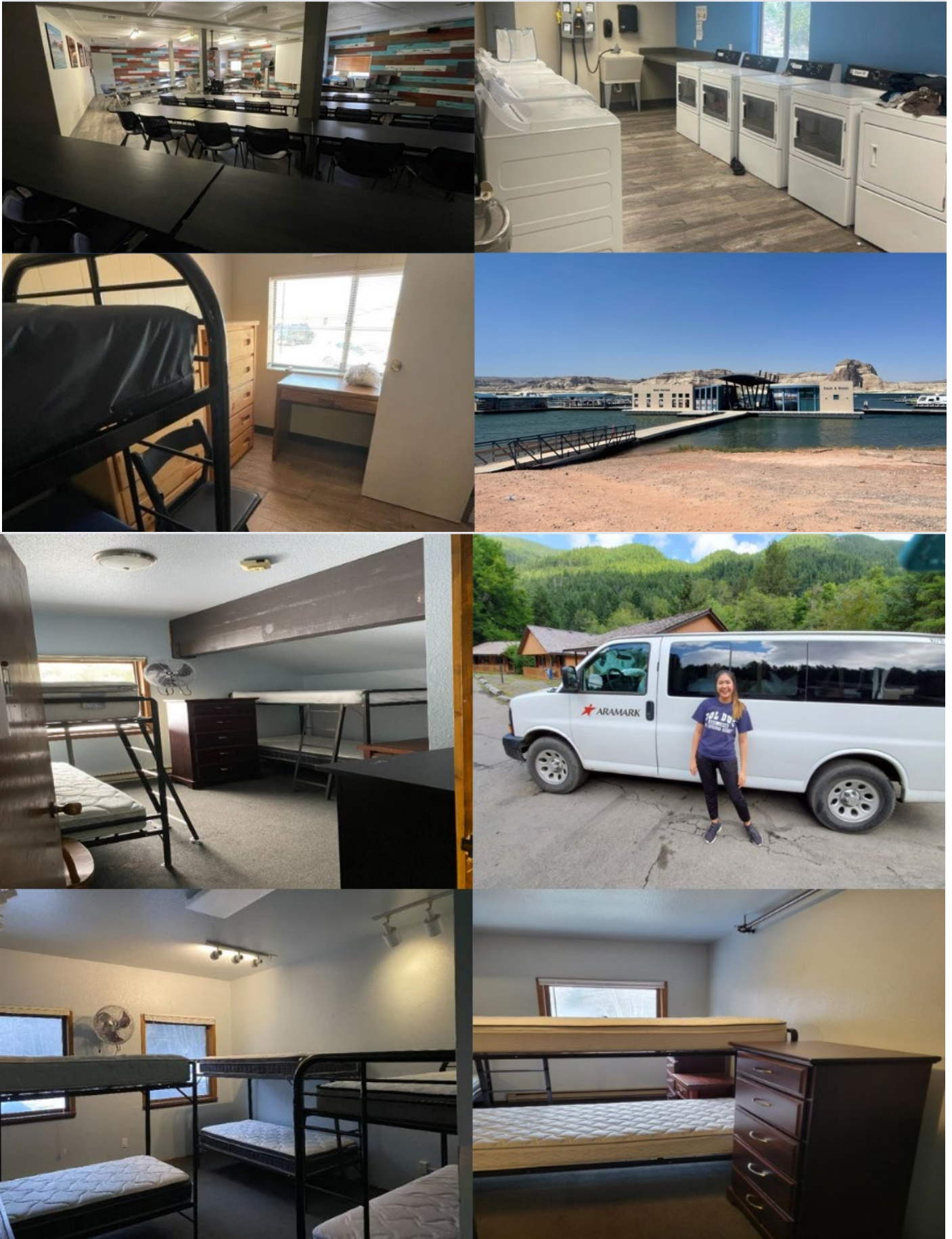
