The Retail Sales Worker is responsible for stocking and inventorying products as well as maintaining the appearance and cleanliness of the retail location. The Retail Sales Worker provides general customer service and assistance to guests and may process sales transactions. Ensure product is stocked to appropriate levels and replenishes and arrange items as needed to maintain the appearance. Responsible for cash handling, safe verifications, and preparing deposits

Cleaning Services Worker - Boat Rentals

The Cleaning Service Worker primarily works as a Boat Cleaner. Cleaning Service Workers are flexible, willing to help out wherever needed, comfortable working outside in extreme heat conditions and committed to achieving the highest cleanliness standards to ensure customer satisfaction. Ensure a clean and pleasant atmosphere





of the boat dock by removing trash and debris from the dock and cleaning all public areas. Must be able to work physically hard and be able to deal with constant lifting and bending. Ensure all beds are made, all surfaces dusted, trash removed, carpets vacuumed, coolers and barbecue grills cleaned, linens changed, and that bathroom sinks, tubs, and toilets are cleaned. Also must measure anchor lines and ensure all common items used are restocked and any damaged or missing items are replaced.

• Guest Services Worker – Boat Rental Agent (Indoor)

Guest Services Workers are the first line of communication for guests renting a boat. Establish a welcoming atmosphere from the minute a guest arrives at the Boat Rentals Office. Guest Services Workers are attentive and always willing to answer questions and resolve guest issue. They execute reservations and educate guests on different boat benefits and add-ons in order to up-sell. Be highly knowledgeable about the marina and surrounding areas and act as a useful resource for all guests. This position requires individuals with high attention to detail, the ability to sell, a strong dedication to customer service, and a positive and friendly attitude.

Marina Services Dockhand – Boat Rentals

The Dockhand is responsible for ensuring guest satisfaction at the marina location by assisting boat crew with vehicle navigation, assisting guests with boat operations, properly maintaining the dock area(s), and providing general customer service. Cleans and maintains docks, restrooms, and public areas to ensure the safety and satisfaction of guests and marina staff. Ensure customers understand boating safety and assist customers with docking boats. Fuels, cleans and maintains boats.

Food Expeditor (Runner)

A Food Expeditor (Runner) is responsible for keeping inventory of, transporting, stocking, and cleaning/clearing product to ensure business and customer needs are met. Stocks and maintains appropriate levels of product. Delivers product and utilizes transfer sheets to maintain inventory integrity. Cleans, sanitizes and maintains the appearance of workstations and guest service areas. Assist servers, bartenders, etc. with customer service as needed. Maintains excellent customer service and a positive attitude towards guests, customers, clients, co-workers, etc.

The Host/Hostess is responsible for greeting and seating guests. The Host/Hostess should provide general customer service within the dining establishment as well as escalate and/or resolve any issues as necessary to ensure guest satisfaction. Greets guests as they arrive seat them accordingly ensuring the optimum use of tables. Ensures any special needs or requests for diners are accommodated and arranged. Maintains the appearance and cleanliness of the front-of-house environment. Escalates any customer needs or concerns as necessary. Works closely with the kitchen staff and servers optimizing communication to ensure efficient operations

Housekeeper

Housekeepers are responsible for cleaning assigned lodge rooms, linens, hallways, carpets and other designated amenities and areas in accordance with the highest cleanliness standards to ensure customer satisfaction. Housekeepers may also collect sort, wash, dry and fold linen from various departments.


