Requirement

- Lifting requirement: 50lbs/22kgs
- Lifting 50lbs/22kgs maximum and/or carrying objects weighing up to 25lbs/11kgs.
- Must have the ability to bend, kneel, and stoop constantly.
- Handling cleaning chemicals.
- Standing for entire shift.
- Varied weather conditions are expected. May work on high or precarious places. Varying schedule to include evenings, holidays and extended hours as business dictates.

- We operate three locations on the mountain, each a little higher up. Students can expect to work at the different locations to get used to the high elevation. Workdays are very long due to the commute up the mountain (10-14 hours).
- At over 4000 meters high, many people experience altitude sickness when going up to the Summit to work. We encourage everyone to take it slow, stay hydrated, and communicate with their managers if they are feeling ill. Altitude sickness is normal, and it can take time to get adjusted to it (usually a few days to a week).
