Position:

- **Lifeguard**

As a Lifeguard, the students will be responsible for Attendant responsibilities as well as Lifeguard responsibilities. This includes guest safety in pool and run out areas. They are expected to always maintain a proactive scanning pattern and always remain in a rescue ready position. Other duties may be assigned.

- **Ride Operator**

Operate ride controls, buttons and switches which may be mechanical, computerized or combination of both. Prepare ride area for opening and

closing each day which may include test runs of the ride. Monitor, warn and enforce rules. Keep all ride areas clean. Effectively respond to emergency situations. This position may include sweeping, scrubbing, mopping, dusting, polishing, power washing, vacuuming, waxing, and picking up trash. Other duties may be assigned.

- **Food Service**

Responsible for cooking or preparing food items according to procedures or recipes. All items must be prepared quickly and accurately ensuring no waste as well as cleaning all food service areas. Also, handling sales which will include taking correct orders, entering sales in a cash register, taking money, counting out correct change (coins/bills), giving change (coins/bills) to customers, and completing credit card transactions. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests. Other duties may be assigned.

Requirement

- Must be able to lift-up to 50lbs/22kgs
- Performing physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending.
- Working outdoor and will have exposure to a variety of weather conditions such as rain, cold temperatures, direct sunlight or high heat and humidity.
- Stand for long periods of time and may be required to sit for extended periods of time on an elevated chair.
- Employees may be asked to move to different locations or job assignments within the property, as needed.
- Nose and lips piercings must be removed, or a clear stud must be put in during working shifts. No extreme hair colors.

Other

- **Overtime:** No, exempt from paying overtime by law
- **Second Job Availability:** Yes, likely.
- All employees are required to work a night shift, a weekend shift, and all holiday shifts.
- All work is weekend only until Memorial weekend and after Labor Day, during the season the park is open full time, and a minimum of 35 hours must be worked.

- Working outside is mandatory. Work is dependent on weather and volume of business. We do what we can to make sure students AVERAGE at least 35 hours. No number of hours is guaranteed.
