Position: Resort Workers

Students will be placed in one of the following positions upon arrival. All participants need to be flexible to the position assigned upon arrival.

Position can vary including Guest Room Attendant, Houseperson, Dishwasher, Busser, Groundskeeper/Greenskeeper, Food and Beverage Cashier, Host, or Retail Associate.

Housekeeper

Housekeepers perform a combination of cleaning duties including clean guest rooms and common areas / public hallway areas. Duties include removing and collecting linens for laundering and transporting them to designated areas, making beds,



cleaning carpets using vacuum cleaner, dusting furniture and equipment, cleaning bathroom, replenishing supplies, and transporting all trash and waste to disposal areas. Other duties will be assigned by supervisors.

Public Space Attendants

Responsible for cleaning the public areas including hallways and public restroom facilities. Will be responsible for cleaning floors, dusting furniture and equipment, emptying wastebaskets/recycling bins and cleaning them inside and out; cleaning tiled floors with the use of brooms and mops; using chemical-based products to clean sinks, countertops, mirrors, toilets, and door panels; replenishing trash bags, soaps, bathroom items, and other supplies; and transporting all trash and waste to disposal areas, as instructed.

Dishwashers

Responsible for unloading the dishes and cutlery brought to them by bussers and loading them into dish trays. The trays are then placed into the commercial washers and blasted with scalding hot water. Occasionally you may be required to wash things by hand.

Bussers

Responsible for clearing guest tables of all plates, glasses, food items, and paper products and transporting these items to the dish area. Will be responsible for wiping tables and chairs, replenishing condiments as needed, and cleaning floors.

Gardener/Groundskeepers

Students will be working outside to maintain the area around the resort or the Golf Course. Duties include watering plants, trimming, and edging, removing weeds, planting flowers, and operating mowers.

Requirement

- Perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, and stooping or bending at the knee to clean for up to 8 hours per day.
- Required to walk or stand for up to 8 hours per day, push or pull a linen cart (up to 100 lbs), lift up to 40 lbs on a repeated basis.
- Handling cleaning chemicals and working under direct sunlight.


