Host

- Welcome and greet guests in a friendly and professional manner.
- Manage wait lists, reservations, and seating arrangements while providing accurate wait times.
- Seat guests efficiently and maintain proper table rotation throughout the dining room.
- Keep menus clean and presentable.
- Respond to guest inquiries, concerns, and complaints professionally, and report issues to management when necessary.
- Maintain seating records and complete opening and closing duties.
- Assist with clearing and setting tables as needed.
- Handle cash and credit card transactions accurately.
- Perform additional duties as assigned.

Prep Cook

- Prepare and process food and beverages for cooking and service.
- Clean, wash, and handle food items following food safety standards.
- Assist with cleaning and sanitizing kitchen areas, equipment, and food preparation items.
- Follow company health, sanitation, and food quality policies.
- Use restaurant POS systems as needed.
- Perform additional duties as assigned.

Houseperson

- Clean guest rooms, public areas, and assigned work areas.
- Operate housekeeping and cleaning equipment safely.
- Deliver supplies and maintain housekeeping supply closets.
- Identify and report maintenance issues when needed.
- Communicate effectively with guests, coworkers, and management.
- Follow company policies, health and safety standards.
- Prioritize tasks, meet deadlines, maintain attention to detail, and work as part of a team.
- Perform additional housekeeping duties as assigned.
- Must be at least 21 years old to service areas where alcohol is present.

Dish Steward

- Performs a variety of entry-level dishwashing tasks. Routinely cleans, washes and stores food and beverage service items, equipment, and the kitchen area. May also monitor/clean the team dining room and set up and break down team dining buffet lines. Assist with other kitchen duties as assigned
- Work in designated station set by the Location Chef / Sous Chef. You may work in guest restaurants or Employee Dining Room as needed and as assigned.
- Keeps all kitchen areas, equipment, machines, etc. clean, sanitized and organized during individual shift. Assist all cooks and chefs as necessary. Assist in daily cleaning and sanitation duties. Maintain cleanliness of all kitchen and dining room materials.
- Follow all machine cleaning procedures. Assist all cooks in daily preparation of menu items. Report to work at designated time in clean, neat and approved uniform. May periodically train new employees or staff from other departments.

Busser

Food and Beverage employees are required to perform various food and beverage related tasks including:

- Placing food items on serving plates or dishes along with required condiments and utensils to present to customers.
- Preparing cold drinks, warm drinks, and other non-alcoholic beverages.
- Some employees will serve alcoholic beverages and must strictly follow all state and federal laws related to serving alcohol.
- All items must be prepared quickly and accurately ensuring no waste and in accordance with production and portion requirements and quality standards while maintaining a safe, sanitary work environment.
- Responsible for handling sales which will include: taking correct orders, entering sales in a cash register, taking money, counting out correct change (coins/bills), giving change (coins/bills) to customers, and completing credit card transactions.
- Responsible for maintaining and cleaning all Food Service areas including preparation tables, equipment, dishes, floors, supply areas, refrigerators,

coolers, sales areas, and customer areas (tables, chairs, serving lines, condiment stands, etc.).

- Demonstrate a high level of customer service. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests.
- Keep supervisor/manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency situations, damages, and potential safety hazards.
- Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all additional training courses.
- Perform all duties in a safe manner.
