**Position:**

- **Room Attendant**

Ensure cleaning and sanitizing of rooms and common areas in hotels, lodges and cabins, including bathrooms, beds, desks, kitchenettes, floors and surfaces. Ensure staff spaces are clean and sanitized. Keep record of potential safety and maintenance issues and communicates details to supervisor. Assist as needed with set up of rooms for special events, meetings, conferences and banquets. Offer assistance to guests and teammates where needed. Deep cleaning of guest and staff space may be required early and/or late season.

- **Dishwasher**

Routinely cleans, washes and stores food and beverage service items, equipment, and the kitchen area. May also monitor/clean the team dining room

and set up and break down team dining buffet lines. Assist with other kitchen duties as assigned. Work in designated station set by the Location Chef / Sous Chef. You may work in guest restaurants or Employee Dining Room as needed and as assigned. Keeps all kitchen areas, equipment, machines, etc. clean, sanitized and organized during individual shift. Assist all cooks and chefs as necessary. Assist in daily cleaning and sanitation duties. Maintain clean and safe work area. Maintain cleanliness of all kitchen and dining room materials. Follow all machine cleaning procedures. Assist all cooks in daily preparation of menu items. May periodically train new employees or staff from other departments.

- **Prep Cook**

Routinely, prepares and processes food and beverages for cooking or service. Cleans and washes food items. Observes company health, sanitation and food quality policies. Assists with cleaning and sanitizes kitchen and food items.

- **Houseperson**

Routinely cleans guest and public areas. Operates cleaning equipment. Makes supplies deliveries and maintains supply closets. Identifies maintenance issues. Ability to clearly communicate, verbally and written, with employees, management and customers. Ability to prioritize work, meet deadlines, maintain an attention to detail, while working in a team or group environment.

- **Host/Cashier**

Greet the guests as they approach the podium and make them feel welcome to the dining room. Seat the guest(s) as quickly as possible or if table is not immediately available accurately informing the guest(s) of how long the wait period will be. Enter guest name and number in party on the wait list and give guest an accurate time of the wait period. For those dining rooms that utilize a reservations system, check guests in and informs them as to the length of time before they will be seated. Keep the seating chart current and seat guests in a proper flow in the sections so as to not over seat any sections. Keep menus clean and presentable and discard any menus that are too worn or tattered. Report any guest complaints and/or issues immediately to the Service Manager or Unit Manager. Respond to such in a professional, sincere manner. Complete

opening and closing side duties according to dining room standards. Maintain seating log to ensure accurate cover count for the seating period. Assist Bussers as needed to clear and set tables. Handling sales in an accurate manner which will include: maintaining a daily bank, entering sales in a cash register, taking money, counting out correct change (coins/bills), giving change (coins/bills) to guests, and completing credit card transactions. Other duties as assigned

Must perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, bending, and climbing stairs. Required to stand or walk for long periods of time. Required lift, push, pull, or carry objects on a repeated basis. Must be able to work continuously in an indoor, humid or hot environment without air-conditioning. May be required to work outdoors with exposure to a variety of weather - rain, cold, direct sunlight, high heat and humidity.

**Prep Cook**

Student will frequently be asked to lift, bend, and stand for long periods of time.

**Host/Cashier**

Students will be regularly required to lift and/or move items up to 50 lbs/ 22kgs.

**All positions require:**

- Handling cleaning chemicals.

- Standing and walking for entire shift.
- No facial hair for employees in food & beverage positions. Men's hair must be shorter than collar length. Must practice good hygiene and deodorant is requested. No extreme hairstyles or colors, only one piercing allowed in each ear and you may be asked to cover tattoos.
