Position:	Resort Worker Students will be placed in one of the following positions upon arrival. All participants need to be flexible with the position assigned upon arrival. All Food & Beverage positions must pass ServSafe Food Handler Training. ● Housekeeping Responsible for daily cleaning of assigned rooms, including making beds, cleaning bathrooms, dusting, restocking amenities, and handling linens. Ensures rooms are guest-ready. Also helps keep public and outdoor areas clean and safe—such as sweeping or shoveling snow.

- **Kitchen Utility/Dishwasher**

Responsible for cleaning and sanitizing all cooking utensils, dishware, pots/pans, and work areas. Duties include clean and organize back dock including surrounding areas/work areas including the pot/pan sink, sweep and mop kitchen floors, break room areas, floors, employee restrooms, walls and shelves including walk-ins. Take out trash and clean trash receptacles. Restock dishes, paper towels, and trash liners and miscellaneous stock items.

- **Busser/Server Assistant**

Responsible for greeting guests and make them feel welcome throughout their dining experience, setting tables according to house standards and meal period placements. Clear finished tables. Assist in keeping dining room clean and orderly throughout shift. Take dirty dishes to dish area in kitchen.

- **Host**

Responsible for greeting guests as they approach and make them feel welcome. Field phone calls as necessary and seat the guest(s) as quickly as possible or if table is not immediately available, accurately informing the guest(s) of how long the wait period will be.

- **Food Outlet Attendant/Cafeteria Worker**

Responsible in serving line, ensuring that all items are fully stocked at all times while maintaining portion control and proper presentation of the item(s) served. Keep serving line clean and sanitary at all times, maintaining temperature logs and sanitation logs. Use proper rotation of product on perishable items at all times considering the First in First out method. Clear and sanitize tables in dining area. Take dirty dishes to dish area in kitchen. Ensure that side stands are fully stocked with condiments, eating utensils and napkins.

- **Pizza Pub Attendant**

Responsible for greeting and seating guests using a computer system, making sure they feel welcome throughout their meal. You'll also take to-go orders, help clear and reset tables, and keep the dining area clean and tidy. It's important to know the current menu and be flexible with the restaurant's operating hours.

- **Retail**

Responsible for assisting customers with politeness and knowledgeable manner, handling store security issues as directed by store management, be aware of product locations, sizes, prices and other information, completing assigned job board on daily basis, and responsible for issue bank including change orders and security of the bank.

- **Guest Service Agent**

Greet all guests and assist with any questions. Check guests in/out of rooms. Operate POS system, manage payments and posting charges to rooms. Maintain guest security, manage assigning guests, manage cash bank.
