Lifeguard

Lifeguarding is a safety critical and medical emergency position. Responsible for guest safety by preventing and responding to



emergencies; enforcing park and attraction policies per SOP; and maintaining constant surveillance of guests within assigned Zone of Protection. Employees in this role will be trained and certified in First Aid, CPR, Basic Life Support, and Water Rescue techniques.

• Rides & Roller Coaster Operator

Interact with guests, perform safety checks, load and unload rides, secure restraint devices, and control panel functions for safe ride operation. Maintain a neat, clean, and professional appearance always by following grooming and uniform standards. Maintain ride cleanliness throughout the day. Complete pre-opening and closing documentation. Consistently operate rides according to standard operating procedures. Provide verbal instructions to guests. Enforce all rider requirements, rules, and park policies. Engage guests on rides and in queue areas. Respond to emergency situations in accordance with standard operating procedures.
