Responsible for performing a variety of entry-level laundry cleaning tasks. Routinely processing laundry items. Processing laundry for the hotel including, but not limited to, weighing, moving, folding and stocking linens (towels, sheets, etc.). Assisting housekeeping department as needed.

● Room Attendant

Ensures highest quality standards of Housekeeping are maintained for our guests and the Company. Responsible for daily guest room and public area cleaning with attention to detail and giving your personal best n service. •Cleans rooms and bathrooms in assigned workstation performing any combination of the following tasks and duties: strips and remakes beds, roll-away and cribs; sweeps and mops floors, vacuums carpets, dusts and polishes furniture and fixtures, cleans windowsills and porches, brushes curtains, draperies and upholstered furniture; empties and cleans wastebaskets and relines with plastic liner; cleans ashtrays and plastic ice buckets;

replenishes towels, bathmats, wash cloths, soap, and amenity and dresser supplies; cleans shower, bathtub, shower curtain and toilet; and restocks tissue. Assists in other departments or with other job duties as requested or necessary

- **Public Area Attendant**

Responsible for cleaning assigned public spaces such as lobbies, hallways, carpets, public bathrooms, conference rooms, stairwells, restaurant areas, outdoor spaces and other designated amenities and areas in accordance with the highest cleanliness standards to ensure customer satisfaction. Public Area Attendants may also collect sort, wash, dry and fold linen from various departments. Must be able to clean at face-pace daily - this includes but is not limited to: all surfaces dusted, trash removed, carpets vacuumed, and that bathroom sinks and toilets are cleaned. Clean public areas including lobby, restrooms, stairwells, hallways, conference rooms and offices. Other duties as assigned.

- **Prep Cook**

Performs a variety of entry-level dishwashing tasks. Routinely cleans, washes and stores food and beverage service items, equipment, and the kitchen area. Keeps all kitchen areas, equipment, machines, etc. clean, sanitized and organized during individual shift. Assist. Maintain clean and safe work area. Maintain cleanliness of all kitchen and dining room materials. Follow all machine cleaning procedures. Work in designated station set by the Location Chef / Sous Chef. Assist all cooks in daily preparation of menu items. Report to work at designated time in clean, neat and approved uniform. May periodically train new employees or staff from other departments. Complies with all health and safety codes in handling and storage of all food products and kitchen equipment. Varied hours; both AM and PM are required. Will work with various soaps and cleaning chemicals. Gloves, aprons and safety materials are provided.

- **Dish Steward**

Routinely cleans, washes and stores food and beverage service items, equipment, and the kitchen area. May also monitor/clean the team dining room and set up and break down team dining buffet lines. Assist with other kitchen duties as assigned. Work in designated station set by the Location Chef / Sous Chef. You may work in guest restaurants or Employee Dining Room as needed

and as assigned. Keeps all kitchen areas, equipment, machines, etc. clean, sanitized and organized during individual shift. Assist all cooks and chefs as necessary. Assist in daily cleaning and sanitation duties. Maintain clean and safe work area. Maintain cleanliness of all kitchen and dining room materials. Follow all machine cleaning procedures. Assist all cooks in daily preparation of menu items. Report to work at designated time in clean, neat and approved uniform. May periodically train new employees or staff from other departments.

- **Busser**

Food and Beverage employees are required to perform various food and beverage related tasks including: cooking or preparing food items according to procedures or recipes, placing food items on serving plates or dishes along with required condiments and utensils to present to customers, preparing cold drinks, warm drinks, and other non-alcoholic beverages. Some employees will serve alcoholic beverages and must strictly follow all state and federal laws related to serving alcohol. All items must be prepared quickly and accurately ensuring no waste and in accordance with production and portion requirements and quality standards while maintaining a safe, sanitary work environment. Food and Beverage employees may be responsible for handling sales which will include: taking correct orders, entering sales in a cash register, taking money, counting out correct change (coins/bills), giving change (coins/bills) to customers, and completing credit card transactions. All Food and Beverage employees will be responsible for maintaining and cleaning all Food Service areas including preparation tables, equipment, dishes, floors, supply areas, refrigerators, coolers, sales areas, and customer areas (tables, chairs, serving lines, condiment stands, etc.). Demonstrate a high level of customer service. Respond to and take appropriate action to resolve concerns and complaints of guests. Keep supervisor/manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency situations, damages, and potential safety hazards. Attend departmental and team meetings as well as participate in all additional training courses. Perform all duties in a safe manner. Employees may be asked to move to different locations or job assignments within the property, as needed. Other duties may be assigned

Must perform physical activities that require moving one's whole body, such as lifting, balancing, climbing, bending, and climbing stairs. Required to stand or walk for long periods of time. Required lift, push, pull, or carry objects up to 50 lbs (23kg) on a repeated basis. Must be able to work continuously in an indoor, humid or hot environment without air-conditioning. May be required to work outdoors with exposure to a variety of weather - rain, cold, direct sunlight, high heat and humidity.
