General duties:

F&B Front of House:

Assist in setting up, cleaning, maintaining, and breaking down dining areas. Ensure cleanliness and hygiene standards in the F&B area are maintained. Serve meals and beverages to patrons, present menus,





answer questions, and make suggestions regarding food order. Complete any side work such as polishing silverware, glasses, folding napkins, etc. Activities:

Support in organizing, coordinating, and setting up scheduled resort and/or ranch activities. Engage with guests to provide an enjoyable experience during activities. Maintain and organize activity equipment and resources. Assist the Adventure Park as needed to include mini golf, mechanical bull, tennis courts, pony rides, rock climbing, pool, game room, and more.

Housekeeping:

Perform tasks within the laundry facility. Groundskeeper:

The primary duties include cleaning dirt and debris, removing trash, and maintaining the beauty of the resort grounds through landscaping and general upkeep. Assist in seasonal decor setups as required. Pick up trash from curbs on the property and surrounding areas to the highway. Sweep curbs and sidewalks. Clean grounds, remove litter, and empty trash cans in the public area buildings. Break down cardboard items and place in appropriate containers.


