Position: Essential functions and responsibilities of the position may vary by Aramark location based on client requirements and business needs.

- **Cashier**

Responsible for accurately processing retail merchandise transactions, greet and assists customers while anticipating their needs, operates a register and handles cash and credit card transactions, count, organize, and balance cash drawer; fill out the cashier slip; and make deposits, and providing customer service to guests of the location. Other duties and tasks as assigned by manager.

- **Custodial Worker**

Responsible for cleans and maintains assigned areas to meet customer and client satisfaction. Properly cleans and maintains housekeeping equipment. Cleans assigned areas to Aramark and client standards and requirements. Follows procedures for storage and disposal of trash and transports it to designated areas. Secures the facility, ensuring building is locked/unlocked as required. Other duties and tasks as assigned by manager.

- **General Utility Worker**

This job is to help ensure guest satisfaction by maintaining all dishes, pots, pans, silverware, glasses, equipment, and kitchen utensils in a clean and sanitized condition. In addition, this job requires that the employee keep the dishwashing machine station, three compartment sink, and related areas clean. Other duties as assigned.

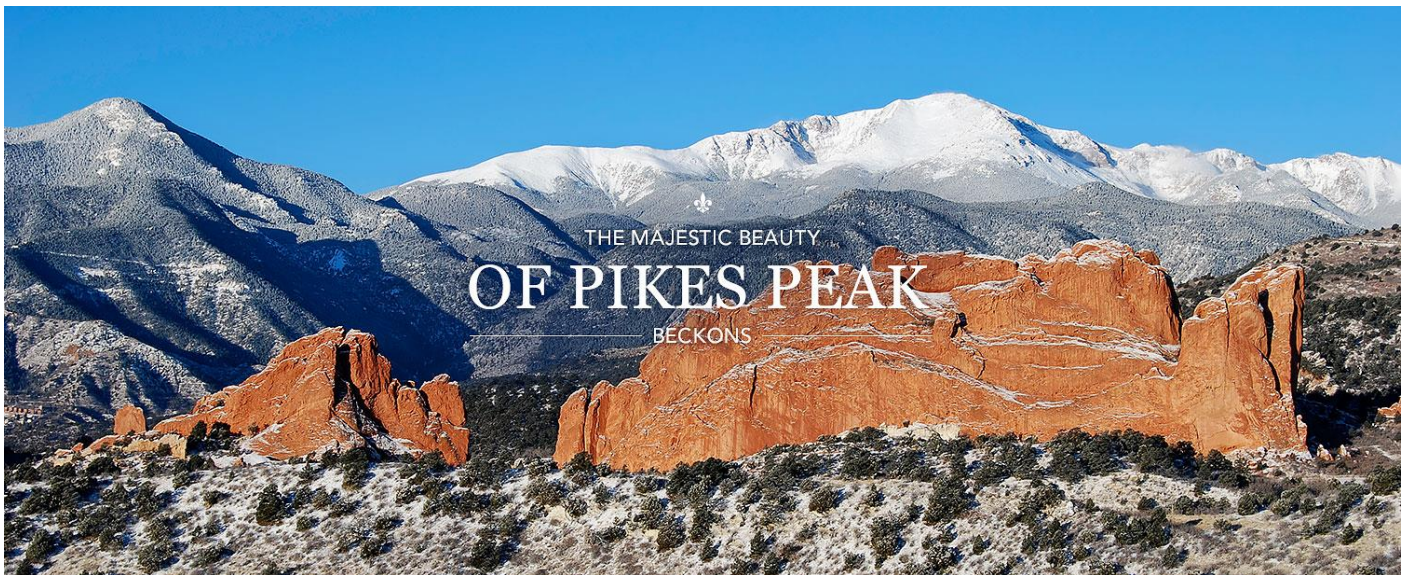

- Requirement**
- Position requires the ability to lift to 23kg and carry up to 11kg. Must have the ability to bend, kneel, and stoop constantly. Standing for entire shift, handling cleaning chemicals and working outdoors.
 - Must be well-groomed and maintain a high level of professionalism. No extreme hairstyles or colors, only one piercing allowed in each ear and you may be asked to cover tattoos.
 - Must be able to work in hot and humid areas.

- **Overtime:** Paid after 40 hours
 - **Second Job Availability:** Yes, likely
 - Students will be working approximately 12-hour days with 2 meal breaks. Students can expect to work in the different operations to get used to the high elevation. Workdays are very long due to the commute up the mountain.
